Who Can Use the Portal?

If you are an ANR (UC Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources) employee or AES faculty and staff, you must be in the ANR Directory to access the portal. First, check to see if you are in the directory by going to: <http://ucanr.org/direct.cfm> Type in your last name and click on the arrow button. It is possible that your email may not match up with the directory listing. If you are in the directory, you will be able to have account access information sent to you. If you are not in the directory, but feel that you should be, contact your office manager, MSO, or website liaison. Ask them to add you to the ANR directory. When you are added, you will receive portal access information.


